2019-2020 NYC Service Fellowship Program

Eligibility

To be considered as a candidate, applicants should meet the following requirements at the time of their application:

- All applicants must hold an undergraduate degree.
- NYC Service Coordinators must meet the eligibility requirements to work in NYC, *i.e.* full compliance with the I-9 form from US Citizenship and Immigration Services.
- Applicants must be prepared to participate in the program on a full-time basis for one full year (August or September 2019 – August or September 2020). While a NYC Service Coordinator in the program, you may not have any additional jobs and/or fellowships. This is a full-time work experience and requires a full-time commitment.
- Applicants *should* have one year of service experience (*e.g.* national service or volunteer service), with priority given to those who have completed a national service program, *i.e.* AmeriCorps State and National, VISTA, NCCC, etc.
- This experience is designed for recent graduates; therefore individuals no more than four years out of an undergraduate or graduate program (*i.e.* graduation in spring of 2019, 2018, 2017, 2016, or 2015) are *strongly preferred*.
